After-School Academics Enrichment Program

assisted elementary school-age children with completion of their daily homework assignments and development of study habits, while providing self-esteem workshops, individualized tutoring to enhance their capabilities in reading, writing, and mathematics, as well as STEAM-related recreational and instructional activities.



Summer Day Camp Program provided elementary school-age children with fun-filled cooking lessons, science experiments, arts & crafts projects, extra-curricular presentations, and recreational activities.
